

Smithfield City has had several discussions over the last week about our response to the COVID-19 virus and how we can help slow the spread.

First, we would like to tell everyone that we consider the safety of our residents and staff to be our most important responsibility as a City.

We are not the experts when it comes to public health issues related to infectious diseases. We received several recommendations over the last few days from the CDC, State of Utah and the local Health Department.

After reviewing these recommendations Smithfield City is taking the following actions effective Tuesday, March 17th:

- All recreation programs are suspended through Monday, March 30th.
- The recreation center is closed to public access through Saturday, March 28th.
- The Civic Center, Youth Center and Senior Center are closed to public access through Monday, March 30th.
- The Library has suspended all programs through Tuesday, March 31st.
- The Library is closed to public access through Monday, March 30th.
- The City Office is closed to public access through Monday, March 30th. All public services are available:
 - **Utility billing:** bills can be payed online, or by utilizing the utility drop box at city hall. Utility services can also be set-up online or access the form on the city website, www.smithfieldcity.org.
 - **Cemetery:** to schedule a burial call (435) 563-6226 to make an appointment.
 - **Zoning:** call (435) 563-6226 to schedule an appointment for subdivision reviews, information on zoning can be located at: Smithfield.municipalcodeonline.com
 - **Business License:** business license information can be located online or call (435) 563-6226 with any questions.
 - **Justice Court:** Most court proceedings are being rescheduled into June, you can pay fines online or over the phone at (435) 563-6226.
