

US-91 RENEWED

1000 North to 900 South in Smithfield

UDOT to Resurface 5-mile Segment Main Street, Build Signals at 1600 N, 3100 N

Beginning May 14, 2018, and continuing through July 2018, the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) will resurface US-91 (Main Street) from 1000 North in Logan, to approximately 900 South in Smithfield. In addition to the resurfacing, new traffic signals will be installed at the intersections of Main Street and 1600 North and 3100 North.

Anticipated Traffic Delays

To minimize delays for the resurfacing work, construction crews are scheduled to work from 9 p.m. to 7 a.m. Sunday through Thursday. Crews will restrict the road to one lane in each direction and narrow travel lanes from 12 feet to 11 feet wide. Motorists should anticipate moderate travel delays.

The intersection of 1600 North and Main Street is scheduled to be closed up to 30 days. Motorists should consider alternate routes if your travel time is sensitive. Please slow down when driving through the construction zone and watch for crews working nearby.
