

Dear Stakeholder,

Below is an update regarding UDOT's work to resurface US-91 from 1000 North in Logan to 900 South in Smithfield.

Construction crews are lowering utility accesses, removing sidewalk corners, curb and gutter at various locations between 1000 North and Hyde Park Lane.

1600 North Intersection

Beginning Sunday through Thursday, from 9 p.m. to 7 a.m., crews will close 1600 North for drainage work. Drivers can use 1400 North or 1800 North as alternate routes **if travel time is sensitive**.

3100 North Area

Beginning Monday at 9 p.m., crews will restrict US-91 to one lane in each direction in the area of 3100 North for emergency pavement repair. Traffic will be shifted to the west side of Main Street which will require closing one southbound lane through May 25. Two northbound lanes will remain open during the day. Motorists traveling south on Main Street in this area should anticipate moderate to heavy delays.

Resurfacing Work

Road resurfacing between 1800 North in Logan and Smithfield is scheduled to begin begin May 29. Main Street will be reduced to one lane in each direction from 9 p.m. and 7 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Please slow down and be watchful of crews working nearby.
