Dear Stakeholder,

Below is a summary of the upcoming work on US-91 from 1000 North in Logan to 900 South in Smithfield.

Roadway Work

Crews have completed a substantial portion of the paving with only minor sections remaining. Main Street will be periodically reduced to one lane in each direction from 9 p.m. to 7 a.m. Clean-up of loose asphalt on side streets, SR-165, and Main Street will begin.

Crews are scheduled to close the intersections of 4200 North and 4400 North at Main Street August 14 and 15 for reconstruction.

Concrete work will continue as crews remove and replace various sections of curb and gutter, and driveways.

1600 North Area

The new signal poles are in place. Crews are scheduled to activate the signal the weekend of August 18.

3100 North Area

Crews are scheduled to set the new signal poles the weekend of August 11. The signal will be activated as early as August 12. Please pay extra attention to the change in traffic patterns at these newly-signalized intersections.
