Dear Stakeholder,

Below is a summary of the upcoming work on US-91 from 1000 North in Logan to 900 South in Smithfield.

*Roadway Work*

Crews are scheduled to finish paving operations on Main Street between 1800 North in North Logan and 900 South in Smithfield as early as Monday, July 30. Once this section is complete, crews will begin removing and replacing the asphalt on Main Street between 1000 North and 1800 North. Main Street will be reduced to one lane in each direction from 9 p.m. to 7 a.m.

Between 2500 North and 900 South in Smithfield, concrete crews are scheduled to remove and replace various sections of curb and gutter, and driveways.

*1600 North Area*

Crews will set the new signal poles and pave the road. 1600 North is scheduled to be closed for paving. Additional information will be provided once a date is set. The signal will be activated once paving work is complete.

*3100 North Area*

Crews are scheduled to set the new signal poles. The signal will be activated once the resurfacing work on US-91 is complete.
