Dear Stakeholder,

Below is an update regarding UDOT's work to on the US-91 repaving project from 1000 North in Logan to 900 South in Smithfield. Crews will reduce the highway to one lane in each direction from 9 p.m. to 7 a.m. Sunday through Thursday for asphalt removal and repaving.

Resurfacing Work

Due to weather conditions, paving and milling has been rescheduled to start Sunday night, June 17. During paving operations, the project team is asking business owners not water the grass areas along Main Street for 48 hours prior to paving work being performed at their location. The project team will notify businesses in advance. If you would like assistance turning your sprinklers off, please contact us, provide your information, and the construction contractor will do it for you.

1600 North Intersection

Work on pedestrian accesses continues and should be completed within the next two weeks. The intersection of 1600 North and Main Street is scheduled to be closed the week of June 24. Additional information will be provided as it becomes available.

3100 North Area

Curb and gutter work is complete. Crews are finishing the underground work connecting all the electrical and communication lines for the new signal. Signal boxes should be installed by next week. The signal poles will be installed the week of June 25. The signal will be activated once the resurfacing work on US 91 is complete and the lane markings are placed on the roadway.

Motorists should expect narrowed lanes and moderate travel delays. Access to area businesses will remain open during the day. This work will continue through July 2018. Contact the project hotline, 877-495-4240 or email us91logan@utah.gov for more information.
