Dear Stakeholder,

Below is a summary of the upcoming work on US-91 from 1000 North in Logan to 900 South in Smithfield.

Crews will not work during the July 4 holiday and during the Cache Valley Cruise-In. Work will resume Sunday, July 8. Once work resumes, the highway will be reduced to one lane in each direction from 9 p.m. to 7 a.m. Sunday through Thursday for asphalt removal and repaving. Paving has been completed on the east side from 1800 North to 3100 N. Milling and paving operations will continue north.

Work on pedestrian accesses continues and should be completed the week of July 9. The intersection closure at 1600 North and Main Street has also been rescheduled to the week of July 9.

Signal work at 3100 North: Crews are installing underground connections for the new signal. The signal will be activated once the resurfacing work on US-91 is complete.

Motorists should expect narrowed lanes and moderate travel delays. Access to area businesses will remain open during the day. This work will continue through July 2018. Contact the project hotline, 877-495-4240 or email us91logan@utah.gov for more information.
