

UDOT to Resurface US-91 from North Smithfield to Idaho

As early as June 20, 2022, the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) will begin a project to resurface US-91 from North Smithfield to the Idaho border. Crews will place a new roadway surface, called a chip seal, along the entire corridor to improve the driving experience and extend the life of the pavement. Motorists should anticipate moderate travel delays, reduced speeds, and intermittent lane shifts and closures between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m., Monday through Friday. Weekend work may take place on occasion if needed. The project is expected to be complete by early-August 2022.



For your safety, and the safety of those working in the area, please slow down and use extra caution while driving through construction zones. Area residents and businesses should expect increased noise, dust, and vibration associated with construction. *Construction schedules are subject to change*.
